In an effort to engage, educate and involve our parents, we will:

- Offer a contract which may be signed a parent/guardian, encouraging positive homework routines and habits. This indicates agreement of the shared responsibility of parents, school and student.
- Provide a description and explanation of district curriculum, forms of assessment which measures progress and at the proficiency levels which students are expected to perform. Our Fall Open House incorporates curriculum, thus educating parents about our initiatives. Conferences are also a time which parents and teachers communicate about growth.
- Inform parents about additional resources and supports, within our school and outside of our building, that may help grow our students.
- Offer additional parent training as needed, so parents may work alongside their children at home in an effort to improve academic achievement.
- Involve parents on School Improvement Teams.
- Offer education and connectivity via PTA/Curriculum nights which both students and adults have appropriate activities and information. Additional PTA nights may involve trainings of non-academic areas such as parent management skills.
- Invite parents to volunteer in a variety of ways, such as backpack book readers, in small groups with homework help, organizing celebrations, attending field trips and leading after-school clubs.
- Regularly communicate via Friday Folders, newsletters, phone calls and notes (hard copies only when needed). Information will be provided in an understandable format and language for parents. Translators will also be called in, if needed.
